Description

This course presents an in depth study of life sciences with an emphasis on Ecology (energy, heat distribution, properties and composition of matter, Earth's processes and environment, the biosphere, ecosystems and their communities); Cellular Biology (molecular chemistry and chemical reactions, cell structure and functions, photosynthesis, cellular respiration and fermentation, cell division,); Genetics (classification, biotechnology, DNA and evolution); Anatomy (Human body systems and plant structures).

Expectations and Goals

Students will be expected to learn, retain information from objectives in order to master material for successful scores of the End of Course Exam mandated by the state of Florida. Students are expected to read material from textbook prior to lessons, show evidence of mastery on assessments, required to complete test corrections when assessment do not show evidence of mastery, and complete all assignments on due dates.

Classroom Rules

- Students assigned to tutoring will earn a project grade for each tutoring session and tutoring will be mandatory.

- Obtain logins from the front office
- There is no limit on how many times parents and students can login to view grades, therefore please use it frequently as I update my grades weekly.

- **HERO** will also be used frequently in my classroom to help provide both students and parents with accurate behavioral tracking.
- Lastly, letters will also be sent home when needed, via email. Parents please expect these as well after progress reports. Parents are asked to attend Parent Conference Days (will be announced). The first parent will be seen at 3:00pm sharp and our last parent of the evening will be seen by 5:50 pm. First come first serve.

MANDATORY LAB FEES:

- Students that fail to submit their lab fee will have to complete textbook work in order to earn a grade for the lab.

- a. Be on time to class each day.
